The class was split into 3 groups and each group was given a plate of fruit. Each group had an instructor helping them who would hold up a piece of fruit and ask 'Trái này là trái gì?' (What fruit is this?) and 'Trái này là màu gì?' (What colour is this fruit?). The students would reply ; 'Trái này (đó) là trái.....' and 'Trái này (đó) là màu.....'

A few fruits not included on the sheet but that were on the plates were: Eggplant – Cà Tím, Pear – Lê and Apple – Táo / Bôm.
